MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2021-023

"AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING GRADUATING SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS OF THE MUNICIPALITY
TO RENDER TREE PLANTING ACTIVITY OF FRUIT BEARING TREES BEFORE THEIR GRADUATION"





The primary goal of this Ordinance is to enhance ecological balance of the community through sustainable green environment.







RESPONSIBILITY OF THE BARANGAY

- a. Each barangay will provide planting materials (fruit-bearing tree seedlings) for graduating students from their barangay;
- b. Each barangay must develop an integrated barangay nursery for propagation of planting materials.





RESPONSIBILITY OF THE MUNICIPALITY

The municipality through its MENRO will perform the following:

- a. Lead and accompany graduating students to the identified planting sites;
- b. Ensure the security of the area and prepare the planting site;
- c. Issue certification to schools and each student who satisfactorily complied with this ordinance;
- d. Provide the seedlings for graduating senior high school who is not a resident of the municipality.





- a. Plant eight (8) fruit-bearing trees;
- b. Each student will bring their own tools and snacks during the said activity







ENFORCEMENT

The <u>Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO)</u> and staff shall conduct inspections at planting sites to ensure sustainability of plant growth; provide needed materials for use of the caretaker/staff.

There will be a caretaker/staff to monitor for the development and growth of the fruit-bearing trees planted.





WHO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENT

As a way of giving incentives, the LGU shall award/provide a <u>badge and a certificate</u> to the graduating students who complied with their responsibility which shall be funded annually from the General Fund of the municipality.
